What is a BREI Ambassador?

An Ambassador represents a state or province by serving 3-year terms with no limit on amount of consecutive terms with duties including:

Requirements

- Active member of BREI
- Must be BREC or BREP certified
- Or, must be dedicated to attaining BREC or BREP certification within 1 year

Ambassadors serve as the eyes and ears of the association and help to connection leadership and staff to opportunities as they are made available.
